SPARKLING WINE & CHAMPAGNE

125ml half bottle

1. **Duc de Valmer Blanc de Blancs Brut NV** £4.95..... £20.95
France (11% abv) A light, dry sparkling wine with clean, fresh, fruit flavours balanced beautifully with subtle floral notes.
2. **Taittinger, Brut Reserve NV**..... £8.95.. £24.95.. £45.95
Champagne, France (12% abv) Crisp, citrus aromas with subtle toasty notes leading to an elegant, balanced palate.
3. **Taittinger, Prestige Rosé NV**..... £55.95
Champagne, France (12% abv) Fresh aromas of wild strawberries and spice precede the balanced, smooth flavours of red fruits.

WHITE WINE

4. **Jacques Véritier Blanc, Vin de France 2009** £2.75... £3.95... £5.00... £14.50
South West France (11% abv) The palate has a good weight of fruit and beautifully balanced acidity that gives the wine a long, fresh, crisp finish.
5. **Pinot Grigio, Via Nova 2009**..... £4.75... £6.50... £17.95
Veneto, Italy (12% abv) Lemony on the nose, with a delicious balance in the mouth, this Pinot Grigio is a very easy-to-drink dry white with medium alcohol and a gorgeous lingering finish.
6. **Chenin Blanc, Man Vintners 2009** £4.95... £6.50... £18.95
Western Cape, South Africa (13.5% abv) Tropical fruit, guava and melon aromas, crisp and bold sweet citrus backed by refreshing acidity and minerality.
7. **Sauvignon Blanc, Mansion House Bay 2008** £5.95... £7.50... £22.95
Marlborough, New Zealand (13% abv) A medium to full bodied wine with vibrant acidity intertwined with crisp fruits and a long and zesty finish.
8. **Douro White, Quinta Do Crasto 2009**..... £22.95
Douro, Portugal (13.5% abv) Bright and pale lemon yellow in the glass with an enticing minerality on the nose followed by crunchy green apple, camomile and lemons. The palate is fresh and crisp.
9. **Gavi di Gavi DOCG, Fontanafredda 2009** £25.95
Piemonte, Italy (12.5% abv) Full and delicate, with an elegant bouquet of flowers and fruit. The palate is attractively young, dry, fresh and well-balanced.
10. **Pouilly Fumé, Château Favray 2008**..... £28.95
Loire, France (12.5% abv) A round, lush wine with depth of fruit, fantastic concentration and superb balance.
11. **Petit Chablis, Domaine Louis Michel 2009**..... £29.95
Burgundy, France (13% abv) This wine is dry, super crisp, light and racy, with mineral acidity, green apple and lemon rind flavours with a refreshing, dry finish.

ROSÉ WINE

12. **Man Vintners Rosé 2009**..... £2.95... £4.50... £5.95... £17.95
Western Cape, South Africa (13.5% abv) A bright cherry pink colour, with aromas of strawberries and tropical fruit. On the palate the wine is crisp and refreshing with red berry fruit flavours and a hint of sweetness.
13. **Pinot Grigio Blush, Il Sospiro 2009**..... £3.25... £4.75... £6.25... £18.95
Veneto, Italy (12% abv) An aromatic nose of freshly crushed cranberries and mineral elements. The palate is light, dry and crisp, with a delicious balance between zingy citrus and fruity red berry flavours.

RED WINE

14. **Jacques Veritier Rouge, Vin de France 2009**..... £2.75... £3.95... £5.00... £14.50
South West France (12% abv) Rich with ripe fruit character and a hint of peppery spice. The finish is well balanced and the tannins are soft and elegant.
15. **Merlot, La Paz, MontGras 2009** £4.50... £6.25... £16.95
Colchagua Valley, Chile (12% abv) Red cherry and plum aromas. Filled with currant, ripe plum, cherry, vanilla and blackberry flavours, complemented by sweet ripe tannins.
16. **Malbec, Sol, Bodegas Santa Ana 2009**..... £4.95... £6.50... £17.95
Mendoza, Argentina (13% abv) Medium bodied and dry with soft, ripe blackcurrant flavours and balancing structure, finishing rounded and juicy.
17. **Podere Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Umani Ronchi 2009**..... £18.95
Abruzzo, Italy (13% abv) This medium bodied, dry wine has a finely textured structure and ripe, plummy fruit.
18. **Billi Billi Shiraz, Mount Langi Ghiran 2005** £5.95... £7.50... £21.95
Victoria, Australia (14% abv) Displays a complex nose, with a broad array of fruit and oak aromas. Medium bodied, with soft blueberry fruit, spices and subtle oak, well integrated tannin and a dry finish.
19. **Pinot Noir, Little Yering, Yering Station 2008** £21.95
Victoria, Australia (13.5% abv) Aromas of strawberry and red cherry fruit with subtle vanillin oak. Well structured and persistent with great depth of fruit and savouriness on the finish.
20. **Fleurie La Bonne Dame, Jean Tête 2009** £24.95
Burgundy, France (13% abv) Medium bodied, soft and supple, with good acidity supporting vivid forest fruit flavours. The finish is elegant, dry and poised.
21. **Rioja Reserva, Vina Cerrada 2005**..... £25.95
Rioja, Spain (14% abv) Spicy cherry bouquet and plum aromas blending with notes of tobacco. The body is full and powerful, with an excellent balance between wood and fruit.
22. **Ser Lapo Chianti Classico Reserva, Fonterutoli 2006**..... £30.95
Tuscany, Italy (13.5% abv) Textbook Chianti Classico, with bitter Morello cherry notes, nicely taut structure and food friendly finish.
23. **Chateau Haut Pezat, Grand Cru, St. Emilion 2008**..... £34.95
Bordeaux, France (13% abv) Hints of ripe plums and damsons on the nose and on the palate. It is rich and velvety, with soft tannin and a long elegant finish.
